JESUS SAVES US FROM OUR ENEMIES

Matthew 27-28; Mark 15-16; Luke 23-24; John 19-20

WHAT IS REPENTANCE?

REPENTANCE IS TURNING AWAY FROM SIN AND TURNING TO JESUS.

Jesus was later arrested and put on trial. The governor Pilate handed Jesus over to be crucified. The soldiers dressed Jesus in a scarlet robe. They made a crown of thorns and placed it on His head, spit on Him, hit Him, and made fun of Him. Then they led Him away to crucify Him. Those who passed by shook their heads, saying "If you really are the Son of God, come down from the cross!"

Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, because they do not know what they are doing." Darkness covered the whole land for three hours. Jesus cried out, "My God, my God, why have You abandoned me?" Then He cried out again with a loud voice, saying, "Father, into Your hands I entrust My spirit. It is finished." The curtain of the sanctuary was torn in two from top to bottom.

A man named Joseph came and asked for Jesus' body. He took it, wrapped it in clean linen, and placed it in his own tomb. A great stone was rolled against the entrance. They placed a seal on the stone and placed a guard there to make sure no one came to take His body.

After the Sabbath day, Mary Magdalene and another Mary came to the tomb. They found an angel of the Lord had rolled back the stone and was sitting on it. He told the women, "Do not be afraid! Jesus, who was crucified, is not here. He has risen, just as He said!" They ran to tell the disciples the good news!

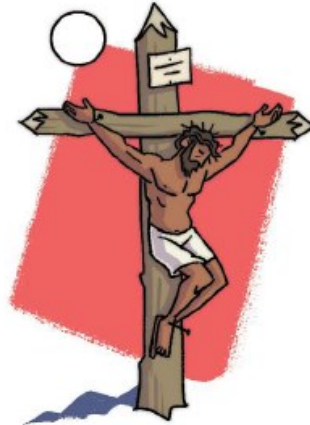
